1. Please call for a reservation before faxing the application form to us (fax no. 3003 6550) or mailing to the address stated above.
2. Once the application is confirmed, the payment *must be settled two weeks prior to your visit (1 month prior to summer bookings)*. In cases of financial constraint, organisations may apply for a fee reduction or waiver.
3. If the application has already been accepted and the school/organisation cancels the talk for reasons other than weather, an administrative fee of HKD100 will be charged.
4. If any changes need to be made to your reservation, please notify us *at least* two weeks prior to your visit.
5. If the school/organisation cancels the talk on the day of the visit for reasons other than weather, no refund will be made.
6. Bad weather and typhoon arrangements: Please follow the Education Bureau guidelines to schools. In the event that a talk is cancelled due to bad weather or a typhoon, you may reschedule the talk with the Society (the re-scheduled date should be within the financial year) or ask for a full refund of the fees already paid.
