Our educational talks are designed so that participants can develop a concern for animals, learn about their needs and feelings, and give careful thought to their well-being. Rundown: The programme is in two parts. The first is an educational talk. Participants will learn about the needs and feelings of animals, the responsibility involved in looking after pets and some of the wider aspects of animal well-being. In the second part, there is a tour of our adoption centre to visit cats, dogs, rabbits, hamsters etc. which have been abandoned and are waiting for re-homing. We hope that these visits trigger a reflection on current human attitudes towards animals, with whom we share the world.

2. Once the application is confirmed, the payment *must be settled two weeks prior to your visit (1 month prior to summer bookings)*. In cases of financial constraint, organisations may apply for a fee reduction or waiver.
3. If the application has already been accepted and the school/organisation cancels the talk for reasons other than weather, an administrative fee of HKD100 will be charged.
4. If any changes need to be made to your reservation, please notify us *at least* two weeks prior to your visit.
5. If the school/organisation cancels the talk on the day of visit for reasons other than weather, **no refund will be made.**
6. Bad weather and typhoon arrangements: Please follow the Education Bureau guidelines to schools (if applicable). In the event that a talk is cancelled due to bad weather or a typhoon, you may reschedule the talk with the Society (the re-scheduled date should be within the financial year) or ask for a full refund of the fees already paid.

Before you come to our centre, we would like to draw your attention to the arrangements we have in place to ensure the safety and comfort of all visitors as well as minimising any potential disturbance at what is a small venue.

### Terms & Conditions for Visits

1. Please call the Education Department on 2232 5526 / 2232 5541 a few minutes before you reach the centre so that we can come down and receive your group.
2. Please take temperature check, disinfect hands, and fill in Health Declaration Form before entering the centre. You will be declined to join the visit if you have a fever or other influenza-like symptoms.
3. All participants must wear a mask. No food or drink is allowed during the visit.
4. If there was a confirmed COVID-19 case in a participant's building 14 days prior to the visit, the participant is required to present a negative result of proof of a nucleic acid test for COVID conducted within 72 hours, otherwise he/she will be declined to join the visit.
5. If there was a confirmed COVID-19 case in a participant's building 3 days prior to the visit, he/she will be declined to join the visit. The group may consider changing to an online talk.
6. Ensure that all the participants are quiet and disciplined at all times. There is heavy traffic at the centre.
7. Do not bring any animals with you to our education talk, whether they have been adopted from the SPCA or not. This is to ensure hygiene in the classroom and the safety of animals and visitors alike.
8. Avoid wearing light up shoes to the centre.
9. Notify our staff well before you come if you require any special arrangement or have a particular request.
10. Follow the instructions of our staff during the whole visit.
11. Photographs will be taken with participating schools or organisations during the visit. The SPCA retains the right to use these pictures for appropriate promotion.
