We have complied with the independence and other ethical requirements of the *Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants* issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA"), which is founded on fundamental principles of integrity, objectivity, professional competence and due care, confidentiality and professional behavior.

The firm applies Hong Kong Standard on Quality Control 1 Quality Control for Firms that Perform Audits and Reviews of Financial Statements, and Other Assurance and Related Services Engagements and accordingly maintains a comprehensive system of quality control including documented policies and procedures regarding compliance with ethical requirements, professional standards and applicable legal and regulatory requirements.

Practitioner's responsibilities

Our responsibility is to form a conclusion on the attached statement of income and expenditure, based on our engagement, and to report our conclusion to you.

We conducted our engagement in accordance with Hong Kong Standard on Assurance Engagements 3000 (Revised) Assurance Engagements Other Than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information and with reference to Practice Note 850 (Revised) Reporting on Flag Days and General Charitable Fundraising Activities Covered by Public Subscription Permits issued by the Social Welfare Department issued by the HKICPA. We have planned and performed our work to obtain limited assurance for giving our conclusion below.

Practitioner's responsibilities (continued)

The work undertaken in connection with this engagement is less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Our engagement included carrying out limited procedures for obtaining sufficient appropriate evidence to be able to draw a conclusion, such as inquiries primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters and other procedures we considered necessary. The procedures performed in a limited assurance engagement vary in nature and timing from, and are less in extent than for, a reasonable assurance engagement. Consequently, the level of assurance obtained in a limited assurance engagement is substantially lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed.

Inherent limitations

Due to the nature of cash receipts and expense relating to the Event, it was not practicable for us to determine whether the statement of income and expenditure and the books and records of the Society include all transactions relating to the Event. It was impracticable for us to quantify the potential impact of this on the statement of income and expenditure. Accordingly, our report relates solely to the statement of income and expenditure prepared from transactions that have been recorded in the Society's books and records.

Conclusion

Based on the foregoing, we report that nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the attached statement of income and expenditure does not reflect, in all material respects, the gross income raised and the expenses incurred by the Society in respect of the Event that have been recorded in its books and records made available to us in accordance with the basis of preparation set out in note 2.

1. General

Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Hong Kong) Trustees Incorporated (the "Society") is incorporated under the Registered Trustees Incorporation Ordinance 1958 for the purpose of promoting kindness, and preventing cruelty to animals.

The aim of the fund raising is to raise funds for the following initiations:

- (1) Animal rescue and cruelty prevention;
- (2) Desexing of animals;
- (3) Adoption services; and
- (4) Education.

2. Basis of preparation

The principal accounting policies adopted are set out below:

The income collected and expenditure incurred for this event held on 6 August 2022 were recognised on an accrual basis.

3. Donations credited to the bank

All the flag day proceeds collected have been credited to the designated bank account of the Society before being used for payment of expenditures for the flag day and the purposes specified in the permit by 24 August 2022.
